PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME – GREETINGS:

WHEREAS: Some high school students may not pursue postsecondary education solely as a result of the absence of information and limited support during the application process. Studies repeatedly conclude that postsecondary education provides significant advantages in terms of income, health, and community involvement to those who attend and graduate; and

WHEREAS: The state of Arkansas works to prepare the next generation for the opportunities and challenges of the 21st century. Increasing the number of citizens pursuing a postsecondary education in Arkansas, including minorities, students from rural areas, first-generation students, and students from low-income backgrounds, is a priority; and

WHEREAS: The month of October marks Arkansas College Application month, a time to help Arkansas high school seniors become more aware of education and training beyond high school, as well as financial aid opportunities, and to provide a forum for students to apply to postsecondary institutions and for financial aid; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ASA HUTCHINSON, Governor of the State of Arkansas, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Arkansas, do hereby proclaim October 2017 as

across the State, and I encourage all students to utilize the resources available to them as they seek to learn more about opportunities for education and training beyond high school.
