PROCLAMATION

EO 17-08

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME -- GREETINGS:

EXECUTIVE ORDER TO DISSOLVE THE PREVAILING WAGE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS: On January 21, 1994, Governor Jim Guy Tucker signed Executive Order No. 94-06, creating the Prevailing Wage Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS: The Prevailing Wage Advisory Committee was created to advise and assist the Director of the Department of Labor in the review of the content, adequacy, and effectiveness of the Department of Labor's administration and enforcement of the Prevailing Wage Law; and

WHEREAS: The General Assembly of the State of Arkansas determined that the law regarding prevailing wages for public works projects placed a substantial burden on Arkansas taxpayers; and

WHEREAS: Act 1068 of 2017 repealed the Arkansas Prevailing Wage Law; and

WHEREAS: The repeal of Arkansas's Prevailing Wage Law has made the Prevailing Wage Advisory Committee obsolete;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ASA HUTCHINSON, acting under the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Arkansas, do hereby order the following:

1. The Prevailing Wage Advisory Committee is dissolved.
2. Executive Order No. 94-06 is hereby repealed.

This Executive Order shall become effective upon its signing, and it shall remain in full force and effect until amended or rescinded by further executive orders.
