**PROCLAMATION**

EO 20-01

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME – GREETINGS:

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER TO PROVIDE FUNDING FROM THE HAZARD MITIGATION DISASTER FUND**

WHEREAS: An effective program for mitigating the effects of future disasters upon local governments is essential to the efficient and orderly operation of the State's business; and

WHEREAS: Mitigation measures to prevent future damage to public facilities are necessary to ensure the welfare of the citizens of the State of Arkansas;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Asa Hutchinson, Governor of the State of Arkansas, acting under the authority vested in me by Ark. Code Ann. § 12-75-101, et. seq., as amended, do hereby authorize the use of Hazard Mitigation funds for the following Hazard Mitigation projects:

City of Bodcaw	Install culverts to prevent roads from flooding on CR 134 and CR 120.	\$5,000.00
Boone County	Install culverts to prevent roads from flooding on Long Creek Road.	\$49,300.00
Conway Corporation	Elevate road to Conway's emergency water pump station to access during flooding.	\$13,680.00
City of Haskell	Upsize culverts at Gary/Harding and Monroe/Grand intersections and Elm Street.	\$10,000.00
City of Highfill	Install culverts to prevent road from flooding on Dukehill Road West.	\$68,674.50
Little Rock Water Reclamation Authority	Elevate Little Maumelle Wastewater Pump Station to prevent outage during flood stage.	\$150,000.00
City of Nashville	Restructure of Lake Nichol's spillway from Mine Creek to prevent flooding.	\$150,000.00
North Little Rock Wastewater	Upgrade White Oak Treatment Plant to prevent outage during flood stage.	\$150,000.00
Polk County	Replace bridge with elevated bridge to prevent flooding on CR 42.	\$62,830.00
Saline County	Replace bridge with elevated bridge to prevent flooding on McGhee Rd. at Taylor Creek.	\$150,000.00
Sebastian County	Upsize culverts to prevent flooding on Bonanza Road.	\$62,500.00
