PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME – GREETINGS:

WHEREAS: More than 70,000 Americans, including 429 Arkansans, had their sight restored last year as a result of corneal transplants. In addition, the Arkansas Lions Eye Bank and Laboratory and its 87 sister eye banks across the country provided more than 20,000 corneas for patients overseas and another 17,000 for research; and

WHEREAS: Arkansans can make the decision to give the gift of sight to others. By registering online with Donate Life Arkansas or with the State Revenue Office and arranging to become eye donors after death, Arkansas donors can ensure that the Arkansas Lions Eye Bank and Laboratory will continue to have the precious tissue needed for sight-restoring cornea transplants; and

WHEREAS: The Eye Bank Association of America (EBAA), the nationally recognized accrediting body for eye banks in the U.S., and member eye banks nationwide have made possible more than 1,000,000 sight-restoring corneal transplantations since 1961; and

WHEREAS: The first National Eye Donor Month was proclaimed by President Ronald Reagan in 1983 and since then, a member of Congress has read a proclamation into the Congressional Record each March to observe this special occasion; and

WHEREAS: The central aspect of the EBAA's National Eye Donor Month commemoration is to raise awareness of the need for eye donors and celebrates the generosity of the more than 50,000 people who become eye donors each year;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ASA HUTCHINSON, Governor of the State of Arkansas, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Arkansas, do hereby proclaim March 2016, as

across the State, and I encourage my fellow citizens to join me in recognizing the generosity of eye donor families who have made possible the more than 400 sight-restoring, corneal transplant operations in Arkansas.
