PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME – GREETINGS:

WHEREAS: Since its creation in 1994, the AmeriCorps National Service Program has been highly effective in promoting the ethic of service and volunteering by engaging citizens of all ages and backgrounds to meet a wide range of community needs; and

WHEREAS: To date, more than 1.2 billion hours have been served by men and women across the Nation, including thirteen million hours from Arkansans, helping to improve the lives of our state's most vulnerable citizens, to strengthen our education system, to protect our environment, and to contribute to our public safety; and

WHEREAS: Since its beginnings with the original signed legislation 20 years ago, AmeriCorps has provided opportunities for over 900,000 citizens to serve across the Nation, and more than 8,300 in Arkansas have answered the call to serve the needs of others through AmeriCorps VISTAs, the National Civilian Community Corps, and other National Service programs; and

WHEREAS: AmeriCorps members recruited and supervised more than four million community volunteers last year, demonstrating the value of AmeriCorps as a powerful catalyst and force multiplier; and

WHEREAS: More than 8,300 Arkansas residents have qualified for Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards, totaling more than \$26,060,000 since 1994; and

WHEREAS: AmeriCorps Week is an opportune time to salute AmeriCorps members and alumni for their powerful impact, to thank all of AmeriCorps' community partners, to bring more Americans into service, and to recognize the 20th anniversary of AmeriCorps; and

WHEREAS: Arkansas AmeriCorps Week 2016 will focus on the critical issue of hunger relief by joining in partnership with community organizations and volunteers to collect, pack, and distribute non-perishable food items for those in our State who do not have enough to eat;


