WHEREAS: The citizens of Arkansas understand the importance of education regarding the topic of Water Safety plays in preventing drowning incidents and recreational water-related injuries; and

WHEREAS: The citizens of Arkansas are aware of the contributions made by the recreational water industry, as represented by the organizations involved in the National Water Safety Month Coalition in developing safe swimming facilities, aquatic programs, home pools and spas, and related activities providing healthy places to recreate, learn and grow, build self-esteem, confidence and sense of self-worth which contributes to the quality of life in our communities; and

WHEREAS: The citizens of Arkansas recognize the ongoing efforts and commitments to educate the public on pool and spa safety issues and initiatives by the pool, spa, waterpark, recreation and parks industries; and
