PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME – GREETINGS:

WHEREAS: National Safe Boating Week is May 20-26, 2017 and will raise awareness that will improve safety and reduce accidents in our Nation's waterways; and

WHEREAS: In the Natural State, where the scenic and abundant streams, lakes, and rivers draw many to relax and enjoy water sports and activities in the great outdoors, it is essential that boating enthusiasts recognize the importance of taking certain precautions, such as always wearing a life jacket and never operating a boat under the influence of alcohol; and

WHEREAS: Approximately 600 people die each year in boating-related accidents in the United States, and nearly 70 percent of these are fatalities caused by drowning. The vast majority of these accidents are caused by human error and poor judgment and not by the boat, equipment, or environmental factors; many of these fatalities could have been prevented if life jackets had been worn; and

WHEREAS: This year's slogan for Safe Boating Week is "Wear It", which encourages the use of Personal Flotation Devices (PFDs) while engaged in water sports;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ASA HUTCHINSON, Governor of the State of Arkansas, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Arkansas, do hereby proclaim May 20th through May 26th, 2017 as

across the State, and I urge all citizens to improve safety on the waterways by enrolling in a safe-boating course, wearing PFDs, and enjoying their time on the water responsibly.
