PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME – GREETINGS:

WHEREAS: The standard of quality in our healthcare system is important to all Americans. Citizens of all backgrounds, whether young or old or from large cities or rural communities, deserve the highest quality healthcare from our health institutions and health professionals; and

WHEREAS: Responsibility for maintaining high-quality standards of this country's healthcare system lies at the heart of public health and will take the efforts of healthcare professionals, our communities, the government, and our healthcare providers and businesses, all working together to promote and enhance the quality of patient care; and

WHEREAS: Patient safety is central to top-quality healthcare in our nation and our state, and increased improvement in patient safety can be achieved by promoting the widespread sharing of best practices within the healthcare industry, as well as by continuous communication between patients and caregivers; and

WHEREAS: Over the last year, 43 Arkansas healthcare facilities actively worked to significantly increase near miss reporting, reveal process and system vulnerabilities, and develop proactive data-driven improvement activities so as to foster a growing culture of safety in hospitals by encouraging the recognition and reporting of patient safety risk;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ASA HUTCHINSON, Governor of the State of Arkansas, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Arkansas, do hereby proclaim March 11th through March 17th, 2018 as
