WHEREAS: Millions of Americans suffer from unpreventable and costly chronic and rare conditions, while the deadliest and costliest chronic diseases, including cardiovascular, stroke, diabetes, cancer, and obesity, are also the most preventable; and

WHEREAS: Chronic Disease Day promotes actionable resources and self-care best practices to reduce individual risk and lower national health care costs for everyone; and
