WHEREAS: Emergency nurses are highly trained to recognize life-threatening issues and solve them on the spot, playing a vital role in treating patients in high-risk situations. They care for those most in need and save lives on a daily basis; and

WHEREAS: Emergency nurses continue to stand strong, no matter the challenges they face or the difficult situations they encounter; and

WHEREAS: These characteristics provide a broad scope of practice for the delivery of critical and complex care within a limited timeframe to health care consumers of all ages and backgrounds.
