PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME – GREETINGS:

WHEREAS: The travel and tourism industry is vital to the State of Arkansas, and the United States, contributing to our economic prosperity, employment, international trade, peace, understanding, and goodwill; and

WHEREAS: Travel and tourism ranks as one of Arkansas's top industries in the amount of revenues generated; and

WHEREAS: Tourism contributed \$7.68 billion to our state in 2019, and during that time more than 36 million visitors traveled in Arkansas; and

WHEREAS: The tourism industry provides jobs for more than 68,000 people in Arkansas; and

WHEREAS: The state continues to gain key tourism products, such as enhancements at state parks, new welcome centers, improved highways, and private sector investments;

across the state, and I call upon Arkansans to observe this week with appropriate ceremonies and activities.


