**PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS: North Little Rock Police Sergeant J.L. “Buck” Dancy passed away on December 2, 2020, in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS: A selfless public servant, Sergeant Dancy’s bravery was a shining example of his dedication to uphold law and order on a daily basis, despite dangerous circumstances to his own personal safety; and

WHEREAS: As a sergeant in the North Little Rock Police Department, he displayed courage, dedication, and a selfless nature as he answered the call to defend the lives of his fellow Arkansans and of all Americans, and the State of Arkansas recognizes his contributions to that esteemed goal; and

WHEREAS: Sergeant Dancy will remain an example for all who wish to serve, and we are grateful for his life, actions, and memory; and

WHEREAS: As evident in Sergeant Dancy’s life, as well as in his death, he had a determination to serve his fellow man. His bravery and actions will continue to inspire the people of Arkansas and is worthy of our remembrance;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ASA HUTCHINSON, Governor of the State of Arkansas, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Arkansas, in tribute to the memory of North Little Rock Sergeant J.L. “Buck” Dancy and as an expression of public sorrow, do hereby direct the United States Flag and the Arkansas State Flag be flown at half-staff from December 3, 2020, to the day of interment.
